




Fluency Software Senate Scorecard 2015-2016

Vote Descriptions

1. SB1766/HB2520 - Holston Hills Country Club authorized to sell alcoholic beverages. FLOOR VOTE: CONCUR IN HOUSE AMEND# 2 4/19/2016
Wait, there's a country club that can't serve alcohol?
2. SB1589/HB1511 - Transmitting or reading texts - moving violation. FLOOR VOTE: THIRD CONSIDERATION AMENDED 4/19/2016
Click it or ticket, Swipe it and Fight it.
3. SB2109/HB2105 - Review of online gaming to protect consumers. FLOOR VOTE: CONCUR IN HOUSE AMEND# 2 4/19/2016
Extensive, long-term review. Snacks provided.
4. SB2304/HB2122 - Public reporting of law enforcement-related deaths. FLOOR VOTE: THIRD CONSIDERATION 4/19/2016
5. SB844/HB301 - Revises definition of municipality for local option sale of alcohol. FLOOR VOTE: THIRD CONSIDERATION AMENDED 4/20/2016
This is a very, very important vote for us.
6. SB844/HB301 - Revises definition of municipality for local option sale of alcohol. FLOOR VOTE: MOTION TO ADOPT AMEND# 2 BY McNally 4/20/2016
We have to change what the word 'city' means to make sure we can get that booze.
7. SB1463/HB2342 - Wildlife officer's experience used to qualify for position with TWRA. FLOOR VOTE: THIRD CONSIDERATION 4/20/2016
Being a wildlife officer generally means you are qualified member of the Tennessee Wing Roaster Association, the state's premiere annual Wing Roasting competition and spicy Wing enthusiasts.
8. SB1912/HB2248 - No state funding for UT office of diversity and inclusion. FLOOR VOTE: THIRD CONSIDERATION AMENDED 4/20/2016
This bill only affects offices in Utah.
9. SB396/HB634 - Sale of alcoholic beverages at retail in unincorporated areas. FLOOR VOTE: CONCUR IN HOUSE AMEND# 2 4/21/2016
Unincorporated areas need their booze, preferably by 5pm today.
10. SB777/HB721 - Certain vehicles exempt from emission testing. FLOOR VOTE: CONCUR IN HOUSE AMEND# 2 4/21/2016
Bill written by Volkswagen LLC.
11. SB2364/HB2381 - Sunset - Hamilton County water wastewater treatment authority. FLOOR VOTE: CONCUR IN HOUSE AMEND# 2 4/21/2016
Like they say, "wastewater, wantwater"
12. SB1912/HB2248 - No state funding for UT office of diversity and inclusion. FLOOR VOTE: MOTION TO ADOPT Conference Committee Report 4/21/2016
A yes vote here, means "No" state funding. A "No" vote here means "Yes" to state funding. A not voting means that the person voted.
13. SB2125/HB2144 - Marijuana research at institutions of higher education. FLOOR VOTE: Motion to Adopt Conference Committee Report 4/21/2016
Truth is, there is already plenty of off the books research being done.
14. SB47/HB813 - Reduces Hall Income tax. FLOOR VOTE: Make Action of the Senate MOTION TO ADOPT Conference Committee Report 4/22/2016
Also provides for a Hall Monitor.
15. SB2481/HB2512 - Report on condition of the unemployment trust fund. FLOOR VOTE: Make Action of the Senate MOTION TO ADOPT Conference Committee Report 4/22/2016
This vote determined whether or not the senators make a motion.
16. SB1796/HB2156 - Disabled veterans - calculation of property tax relief. FLOOR VOTE: Make Action of the Senate MOTION TO ADOPT Conference Committee Report 4/22/2016
Also provides for relief for property tax anxiety, in pill form
